## Newsletter – January 2006

Firstly, I must inform you of the resignations of both Michael Bowyer and Eileen Goddard as two of our Trustees. At the present time we shall not be replacing them and shall continue to run with the three remaining trustees. We also welcomed Mary Cripps-Warwick on to our committee, who I'm sure will be a great asset.

2005 was a very eventful year for the Trust, beginning with the death of Auntie Vera, and at the end of the year Henry Bowyer one of our original trustees; then seeing two major events come to fruition, our room at MERL and the final publication of the Wokingham Agricultural Association History Book written by Kerr Kirkwood, and then at the end of the year losing two of our long term trustees.

Also last year we have continued to support Berkshire Federation of YFCs, both as a whole and also Bracknell in particular, following an application from this small up and coming branch to help sponsor an educational weekend.

We have continued to support a young student on a 5 year course at a Somerset Agricultural College, and have agreed to support an older student on a 3 year degree course in Northumberland. We are only able to do this because we continue to get donations from the WRAA and Swallowfield shows, and earn income from the Trust's land for the Car Boot Sales, and agricultural rent from Thompson & Cripps, whose family are most helpful to the Trust in many ways.
